DISTRICT 3 ASNA GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Three scholarships will be awarded each year for eligible applicants from ADN , BSN, and Graduate (masters or doctoral) students based on the following criteria:

The applicant must have a cumulative grade point average which is equivalent to a 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

The applicant must be a Alabama resident.

Applicant must be enrolled in six credit hours or more per semester to be considered.

Preference will be given to applicants engaged in full-time study.

Documentation to be submitted with the application

Copy of official transcript of grades from last academic institution attended.

Two letters of recommendation. One must be from a faculty advisor and one must be from an employer. At least one should reflect applicant's commitment to nursing. All must be in original form, and must be signed and addressed to the ASNA District 3 scholarship committee.

Narrative statement describing the person's anticipated role in nursing in Alabama, upon completion of the nursing program.

Letter from the school verifying the of applicant's acceptance in the nursing program.
