Withdrawing from Classes:

What happens if I drop all of my classes (completely withdraw)?

Federal financial regulations specify that a student who completely withdraws or stops attending class prior to completing 60% of a term will not be considered as having earned 100% of the financial aid. Therefore, if you completely withdraw from school or quit attending class, a Title IV Refund calculation will be performed by the Financial Aid Office to determine if you must repay a portion of or your entire financial aid award.

While withdrawals do not affect grade point averages, they may have a negative impact on your financial aid eligibility. Students withdrawing from classes should talk with a financial aid administrator before withdrawing from classes.
