

Voter Registration Information

CACC believes in the democratic process and makes every effort to educate students regarding the importance of exercising their right to vote. The College is required to distribute voter registration forms to students for federal elections and state elections for Governor. In an effort to distribute voter registration forms to students, the College conducts periodic voter registration drives and makes forms available on the College campuses.

Qualifications

To register to vote in the State of Alabama, an individual must meet the following qualifications:

- Be a United States citizen
- Reside in Alabama
- Be at least 18 years old
- Have not been convicted of a disqualifying felony (or have rights restored)
- Have not been legally declared “mentally incompetent” by a court

Deadline to Register

Voter registration is closed for the ten (10) days before an election.
