ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Paragraph 5

Central Alabama Community College requires a state approved placement assessment for all students who cannot submit official documentation of ACT (20 or higher in Math, Reading, and 18 or higher in English) or SAT scores for exemption. The state approved placement assessment is a computerized test for “first-time college students” or “readmit” or “transfer” students who have not tested within the last three years. The test is untimed and assesses abilities in English, reading, and mathematics and determines appropriate class placement for these courses. With this information, students and their advisors will be able to increase chances for success by selecting appropriate classes.

DUAL ENROLLMENT/DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM

Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit

Students registering for any college-level English or math courses must take the state approved placement assessment to determine their academic preparedness for college-level courses. Students registering for career and technical education courses, with the exception of math and English, in the 10th or 11th grade should not be required to take the state-approved placement test. Students must take the state-approved placement assessment before the start of their 12th year of high school, or submit ACT scores which exempt them from the exam (18 or higher on ACT English, and 20 or higher in Reading and Mathematics).
