PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline for applying through CACC: February 13, 2017 by 4:00 p.m.

The University of Alabama will provide a Presidential Scholarship to an outstanding student transferring to The University of Alabama from Central Alabama Community College. The Presidential Scholarship covers the cost of in-state tuition for four semesters, provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA. To receive the scholarship, the student must have earned an associate's degree from Central Alabama Community College and maintained at least a 3.5 cumulative grade point average and must be admitted to UA by March 1st. The value of the Presidential Scholarship will adjust as the cost of tuition increases. The current value of this scholarship is \$20,940 over four semesters.

The following documents are required for consideration of this scholarship:

- ** Letter from applicant addressed to the Scholarship and Financial Aid Committee explaining in detail why they feel they should be considered for this scholarship;
- ** Two current letters of recommendation from College instructors, counselors, etc;
- ** A list of extracurricular activities; and
- ** A working copy of your CACC transcript verifying a 3.5 or higher GPA.
- ** Verification of Associate Degree completion or transcript evaluation indicating you are completing your Associate Degree requirements during the Spring Semester 2017.
