Recipients are required to sign an award letter detailing specific scholarship requirements.

Performing Arts Scholarship (requires a minimum 3.0 GPA and \*audition for consideration)
Applicants will be contacted to arrange an audition. Selected recipients must enroll for three (3) credit hours each semester in an approved performing art course. Student must maintain full-time status and a cumulative 3.0 GPA. This scholarship covers in-state tuition and fees up to two academic years or completion of program of study, whichever occurs first. Recipients are required to sign an award letter detailing specific scholarship requirements.

Recipients MUST enroll in one of the following: Certificate, Associate in Occupational Technology, or Associate in Applied Science Programs.
