Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarship Committee:

- Scholarships will be awarded by a scholarship committee which will be comprised of faculty from the three (3) campus.
- Scholarship committee will recommend and notify the director if the award is granted.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for a music scholarship students must do the following:

- Student make application and have been accepted by the time awards are made.
- All students must take and pass the posted audition process.
- Student must enroll in the awarding ensemble for credit. Should the student enroll and drop the ensemble, the complete award is forfeited.

Audition/Award Process:

- Scholarship awards will be made based on the completion of a live audition. If a student is unable to attend i.e. due to distance and other circumstances, student should contact the Director to make arrangement for a Skype, DVD or You Tube link of their performance.
- Auditions will usually be held on campus between November and April. Specific audition dates and times will be posted on the website.
- Auditions will be administered by the Fine Arts Faculty. Scholarship deliberations will begin immediately after the final posted audition date.
- The Director will review the results and recommendations and present to the scholarship committee for award distribution.
- Student will receive written notification of award. Student must return the letter of acceptance by post posted deadline on the letter. Awards will not be credited to students account with the written and signed letter of acceptance.
- This award consist of instate tuition and fees for a maximum of two years of four (4) semesters.
