SUBSTANTIAL CONNECTIONS

High School and college transcripts from all previously attended institutions as well as other official documents such as GED transcripts must be mailed directly from the previously attended institution.

- Check with the School of Nursing for application deadlines and additional requirements.

Financial Aid applications must be submitted online at www.fafsa.gov using the federal school code (001007). Processing of financial aid applications may take up to two weeks, and applications cannot be processed until all required enrollment and financial aid documentation is received. The enrollment and financial aid process must be completed early in order for the financial aid office to complete confirmation process by tuition deadlines and to avoid being dropped from classes.

In order to enroll in college-level courses, students must provide evidence of appropriate ACT, SAT, or assessment placement scores. Information about the assessment placement test and the assessment testing process may be found on the College website.
