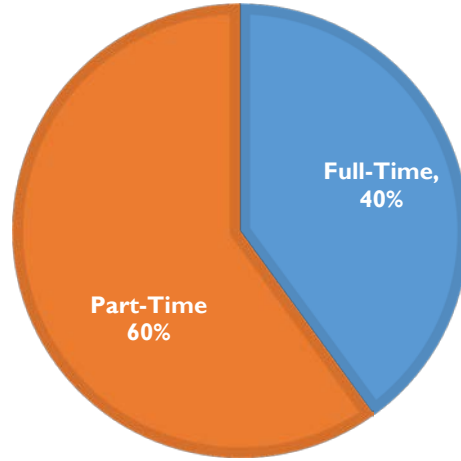

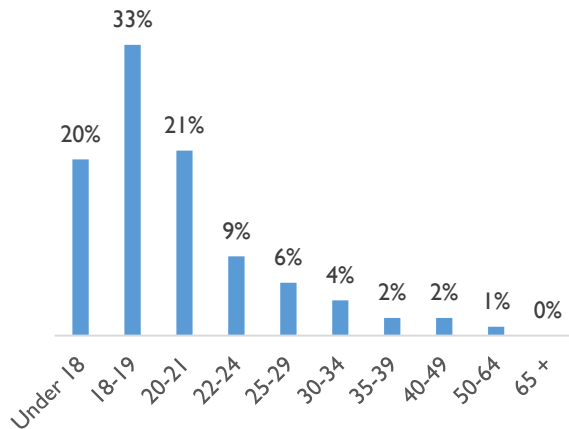
Residency Status of Students

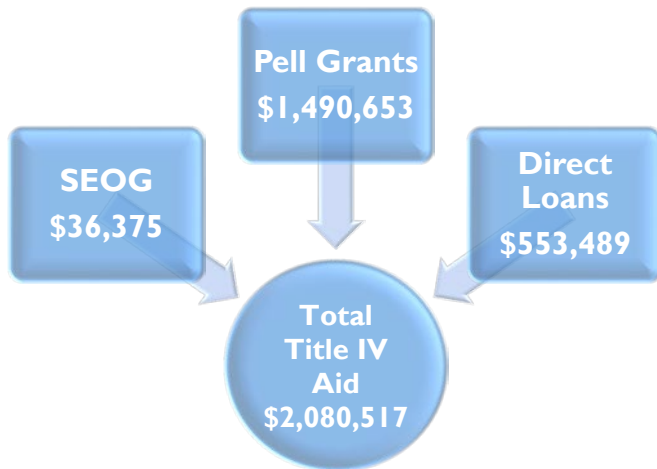

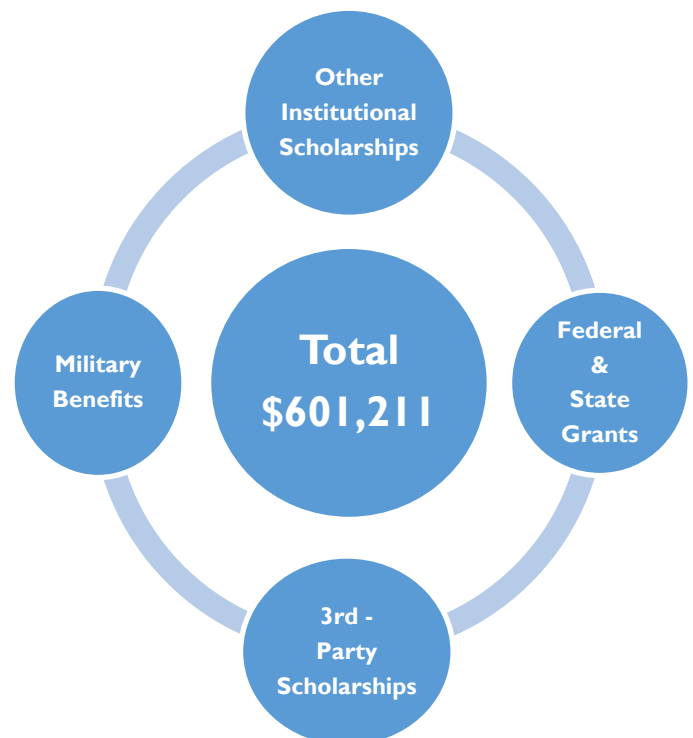
