## Non-Credit Skills Training

The College provides short-term non-credit skills training options designed to prepare students for high-demand job opportunities. Students complete competency-based courses leading to short term credentials and licensure required by industry.

## Phlebotomy (10 weeks)

This non-credit program is a 10-week, non-credit certificate program. Phlebotomy technicians are critical team members in hospitals, diagnostic laboratories, and blood donor centers. While gaining skills essential to the role of a phlebotomy technician, the student will learn to be professional members of the healthcare team. Upon completion, the participants will be eligible to take the Phlebotomy Certification. Participants must be at least 18 years of age with either a GED<sup>®</sup> or high school diploma. The total cost for this non-credit certificate program is \$1,700, which includes tuition, books, supplies, and the certification exam.
