Items Needed to Register for Class:

1. DOT Physical Medical long form and card
2. DOT Drug Test Results (negative results)
3. Current/Valid Alabama Driver License
4. MVR Report
5. Be at least 18 years of age
6. Learner's Permit – Training available through Adult Education
7. TAT (Truckers Against Trafficking) Certificate through Adult Education

Note: All items must be completed and turned in one week prior to the 1st day of class.

Drug Screen results & MVR report must be dated within 30 days of the start of class.

All students are subject to random alcohol & drug screening during the course of the 6-weeks.

No High School Diploma or GED required
