#### **Items Needed to Register for Class:**

- 1. DOT Physical Medical long form and card
- 2. DOT Drug Test Results (negative results)
- 3. Current/Valid Alabama Driver License
- 4. MVR Report
- 5. Be at least 18 years of age
- 6. Learner's Permit Training available through Adult Education
- 7. TAT (Truckers Against Trafficking) Certificate through Adult Education

Note: All items must be completed and turned in <u>one week prior</u> to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of class.

**Drug Screen results & MVR report must be dated within 30 days of the start of class.** All students are subject to random alcohol & drug screening during the course of the 6-weeks.

#### No High School Diploma or GED required
