Cost: *\$4,000 (Includes tuition and books ONLY)

Additional Costs:

DOT Physical - \$100 DOT Drug Screen - \$50 to \$60 MVR - \$5.75 Learner's Permit - \$36.25 CDL License Class A - \$66.25 (Price may vary)

Each course consists of six (6) weeks

Items Needed to Register for Class:

- 1. DOT Physical Medical long form and card
- 2. DOT Drug Test Results (negative results)
- 3. Current/Valid Alabama Driver License
- 4. MVR Report
- 5. Be at least 18 years of age
- 6. CDL Learner's Permit
- 7. TAT (Truckers Against Trafficking) Certificate

Note: All items must be completed and turned in one week prior to the 1st day of class.

Drug Screen results & MVR report must be dated within 30 days of the start of class.
All students are subject to random alcohol & drug screening during the course of the 6-weeks.

No High School Diploma or GED required
