Applicants will be required to demonstrate a three (3) minute presentation on “The Benefits of Attending Central Alabama Community College” and participate in an interview with the Ambassador Scholarship Committee.

- _____ (1) I meet the Ambassador Scholarship application requirements.
- _____ (2) I have completed and submitted an Application for Admission to Central Alabama Community College.
- _____ (3) I have completed the 2019-2020 FAFSA. **Scholarship applicants are *REQUIRED* to complete the 2019-2020 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on-line (fafsa.gov). You MUST include the CACC federal school code 001007 on the FAFSA application. Failure to provide CACC’s federal school code on the FAFSA will result in an incomplete application.**
- _____ (4) ***STUDENTS GRADUATING PRIOR TO 2019*** must provide an unofficial transcript for *ALL* colleges attended and an unofficial copy of the high school transcript. ***Official transcripts showing a graduation date are required by the Office of Enrollment Services prior to enrollment.***
- _____ (5) I understand that failure to meet the GPA requirements and/or failure to provide **all** required documents will result in my Scholarship Application Packet being marked ***INELIGIBLE***. I understand it is my responsibility to verify my packet is complete. ***Due to the large number of applications received, students will not be notified of incomplete packets prior to application deadline.***
- _____ (6) I understand scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis, and meeting minimum eligibility requirements will not guarantee applicants will be awarded a scholarship.
