YOU QUALIFY FOR ADDITIONAL CARES ACT FUNDS IN THE CENTRAL ALABAMA COMMUNITY COLLEGE PHASE II FINAL DISTRIBUTION PROCESS!

The recently enacted Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act, which was passed by Congress and signed into law, provides funding to colleges and universities through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). The HEERF program allows institutions to provide emergency financial grants to students for specific expenses related to cost of attendance that were a direct result of the disruption of campus operations due to the national COVID-19 pandemic.

Student eligibility for HEERF grant funds was determined by Central Alabama Community College (CACC) based on guidance from the U.S. Department of Education's HEERF Funding Certification and Agreement, HEERF Student FAQs, Sections 18004(a)(1) and 18004(c) of the CARES Act, and Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965, as amended.

In addition to information contained in your student record, your completed 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was used to determine the necessary information for identifying basic eligibility criteria outlined in Section 484 of the Higher Education Act (HEA).

Your *final* award check is included with this correspondence and was calculated based on your enrollment and/or reported participation. Realizing every eligible student was impacted from the transition to an 100% online instructional delivery method, CACC recognized students with larger enrollment loads would experience a greater expense in transitioning to remote online instruction. Taking this into consideration, CACC established the following final funding Phase II tiers based on verified attendance/participation for Spring 2020 as of March 13, 2020:

- Tier 1 Full-time status (12 or more semester credit hours) \$169.40
- Tier 2 Three-quarter time status (9-11 semester credit hours) \$129.52
- Tier 3 Half-time status (6-8 semester credit hours) \$89.67
- Tier 4 Less than half-time status (5 semester credit hours or less) \$49.83
